Youth

Services and advice on general health, sexuality, drugaddiction, family problems and more.

Youth clinics: contraception, serving pregnancy, blood-borne and sexually transmitted infections.

Psychosocial consultations and support in crisis situations.

Please note that under the terms of rights recognized by the Civil code of Québec, 14-year-old people and older can obtain health and social services in all confidentiality.
